

# APPLYING TO UCONN: ADMISSIONS & FINANCIAL AID



### HOW TO APPLY FOR AID

- 1 Apply online at studentaid.gov.
- 2 Student and parent create an FSA ID to begin and complete the FAFSA.
- Complete the 2024-2025 FAFSA, which will be available in December 2023.
- Review the FAFSA Submission Summary, a document generated from the FAFSA that gives basic information about eligibility for federal student aid.



## DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY

U.S. Citizen or Eligible Non-Citizen\*

Enrollment or acceptance in eligible program of study

Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) compliance for continuing students

\*Applies to students eligible to file the FAFSA.
